

East sector infrastructures

The main motivation that led me to run for the mayoralty of Léry in 2021 was to ensure that the Eastern sector could finally have quality drinking water for everyone. It was equally imperative that a sewage system be chosen based on the citizens' ability to pay, while also respecting the environment and the topography of this area.

With the invaluable assistance of counselor's Liette Lamarre and Daniel Proulx, we succeeded: a record grants of \$51 million for infrastructure in the East sector, thanks to the municipal water infrastructure program (PRIMEAU) and the individual water treatment units' program (PUIT) by invitation-only for the establishment of a low-pressure sanitary network (Réseau sanitaire à basse pression - RSP).

Important facts to remember:

- The **start of the work** is planned for **spring 2026**.
- The **replacement of septic tanks will be covered by subsidies** AND the cost of **connecting the sewer** system on the citizen property, from the house to the street, **will be covered at 95%**
- From the beginning of this project, we committed to **transparency** and held multiple **community meetings** to keep you informed of all new developments in this project
 - **91% of respondents expressed support for such a project.**
- The upgrading of private sanitary installations will be mandatory in 2027; **the status quo is no longer an option**. Waiting longer means paying even more for this project
- **Infra East needs continuity to exist, otherwise we will lose the funding**
